DARKE RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE Electric Water Heater Rebate PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026

The installation of a new electric water heater in a home, office or other building which uses electricity from Darke Rural Electric Cooperative (Darke REC) qualifies for a rebate. The new water heater may be placed in a new or existing building.

The purpose of the requirements which follow is to aid Darke REC in inspecting and verifying the water heater installation's eligibility for a rebate from the cooperative. **All requirements must be met to receive a rebate.**

A. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Qualified Equipment and Installation
 - a. An electric water heater for original installation (in new construction) or that replaces an existing water heater.
 - b. The water heater must be a new electric storage tank unit that is greater than 90% efficient (greater than 0.90 EF).
 - c. Heat pump water heater must be new unit with a storage volume of 55 gallons or less.
 - d. The water heater shall comply with all applicable local and Ohio plumbing and electrical code requirements.
- 2. A load management switch must be installed on the water heater which should remain installed for a minimum of five (5) years.

B. <u>ELIGIBILITY FOR REBATE</u>

- 1. The building must be a residential, commercial or industrial structure which uses electricity From Darke REC.
- 2. Rebate is to be paid to the Cooperative member who owns the building, or for new construction, the rebate can be paid to the builder/dealer.

C. CONDITIONS OF REBATE

- 1. On-demand water heaters are <u>not</u> eligible for this program.
- 2. The installation of the water heater must be approved by Darke REC.

D. REBATE

- 1. A \$200 rebate will be paid to the member on the basis of one rebate for each unit installed.
- 2. A \$250 rebate will be paid to the member on the basis of one rebate for each qualified unit installed that also has a load management switch installed for OEC direct load management efforts. Only a new switch (where a previous switch does not exist) is eligible for the rebate. An existing switch transferred from an old water heater to a new unit is not eligible. The rebate goes to the consumer, or for new construction, the rebate can be paid to the builder/dealer.
- 3. A maximum of two rebates may be paid per consumer-member home.

E. ANNUAL PROGRAM REVIEW

The Darke REC Board of Trustees will annually review this program for continuation as applicable.
